

Holiday Security Checklist

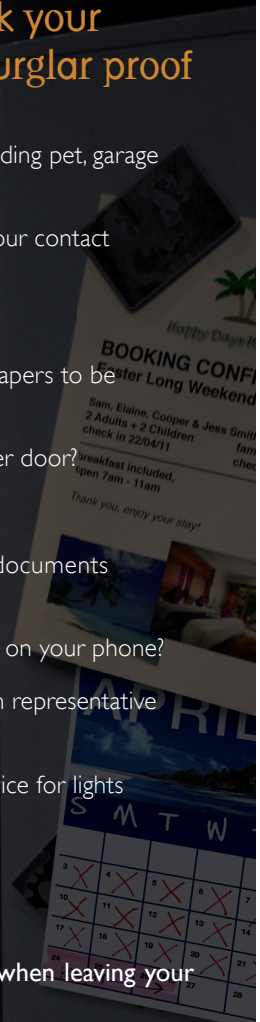
With every 'yes' you tick your home becomes more burglar proof

- Have you turned down the ring volume on your phone?

- Have you set your automatic timing device for lights and TV or radio?

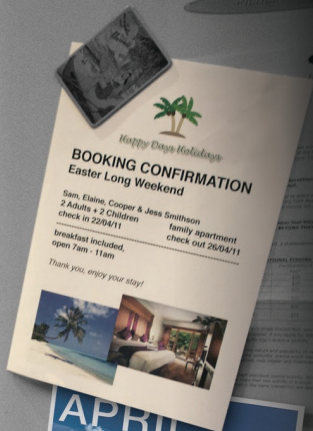
Tips
