Tips for theft prevention

- Make your security visible Deterrence works
- Always use a locking device and chain, attach through front/rear wheel or frame to a fixed object
- Don't let your bike/scooter go quietly, install an alarm
- Always use your steering lock
- Covering your bike/scooter can reduce the risk of theft
- When in public leave bike/scooter in full view
- Ensure your garage is secured, once inside the thief has seclusion and time
- Secure your helmet and riding gear away from the bike/scooter
- Mark all major parts with engraving or use micro dots for identification
- Consider removing your kick-starter
- Keep details and a photograph of your bike/scooter

Record the details of your motor bike/scooter and keep this card in a safe place.

These details will be required by Police and/or insurance company in case it is stolen.
